

# *Private Security*

## *July 2011*

AMENITY PASS – When you are out fishing at a green area, cruising in your boat or laying out on the beach, you WILL be asked to show your Lake Holiday amenity pass. You may also be asked to show a photo ID to show that the name on your LH pass matches your true identity. If you are fishing, you will be asked to produce a valid Illinois fishing license. The Private Security staff intends to continue strict pass checks at every green area and beach. The Marine Patrol will also ask you for your pass, and they will ask you to show them your 2011 LH boat registration sticker.

You will also notice the BEACH OPEN/CLOSED signs at Beach 1 and Beach 2 that includes the additional direction: MEMBER PASS REQUIRED. The primary function of Lake Holiday Private Security is to ensure that the property of Lake Holiday remains - private.

BEACH 2 – We have had reports of residents and their guests swimming off the dock at Beach 2 near the pavilion. SWIMMING OFF THE DOCKS IS NOT ALLOWED. Beach 2 has a large designated swimming area designed for your safety. Please stay in designated swim areas, marked with buoys and swim ropes.

GUEST POLICY – This rule states that members are REQUIRED to be physically present with their guests while they are using an amenity. The fine for a guest policy violation is \$100.00.

OVERNIGHT PARKING – During darkness hours, any vehicle that is parked incorrectly on the roadways of Lake Holiday will receive a warning letter regarding this violation. If you or one of your guests park on the shoulder of the roadway during the hours of darkness, please be sure that the vehicle is parked with all four (4) tires OFF the roadway.

BARKING DOGS – We have a few complaints about residents leaving their dogs outside to bark for long durations during the day. Other residents have complained about this activity after dark. Please extend courtesy to your neighbors and bring your dog inside if it barks continuously.

*CURFEW – All persons under the age of 18 are not allowed to be out after 11pm – Sunday-Thursday and 12am on Fridays & Saturdays. Any subjects under the age of 18 will receive a Lake Holiday citation for \$100.00 and may face a State charge and arrest by the LaSalle County Sheriffs Department.*
