

## PRIVATE SECURITY REPORT

AMENITY PASS – When you are out fishing at a green area, cruising in your boat or laying out on the beach, you WILL be asked to show your Lake Holiday amenity pass. You may also be asked to show a photo ID to show that the name on your LH pass matches your true identity. If you are fishing, you will be asked to produce a valid Illinois fishing license. The Private Security staff intends to continue strict pass checks at every green area and beach.

LITTER ON THE LAKE – Recently we have had many complaints and the marine patrol staff have noticed lots of litter on the lake. Most of the litter described ranges from aluminum cans to Styrofoam canisters. Please do not throw any litter on the lake. The fine for this offense is \$200.00.

BEACH 2 – We have had reports of residents and guest swimming off the dock at Beach 2 near the pavilion. SWIMMING OFF THE DOCKS IS NOT ALLOWED. Beach 2 has a large designated swimming area designed for your safety. Please stay in designated swim areas, marked with buoys and swim ropes.

BURNING – With the Fall weather approaching, we would like all residents to comply with the two LH rules regarding burning.

6.04 – Burning. No open fires shall be left unattended. All ashes should be disposed of properly so as not to enter the lake. No person shall cause or allow open burning of garbage, building debris, refuse or construction trade waste. CLASS A VIOLATION

6.05 – Burning in Ditches – Buring or disposal of landscape waste (trees, tree trimmings, branches, brush, weeds, stump, LEAVES, grass shrubbery and yard trimmings) in drainage ditches is prohibited. CLASS C VIOLATION.

OVERNIGHT PARKING – During darkness hours, any vehicle that is parked incorrectly on the roadways of Lake Holiday will receive a warning letter regarding this violation. If you or a guest plan on parking on the shoulder of the roadway during the hours of darkness, please be sure that your vehicle is parked with all four (4) tires OFF the roadway.

CURFEW – I just wanted parents and juveniles to know our curfew hours:

*All persons under the age of 18 are not allowed to be out after 11pm – Sunday-Thursday and 12am on Fridays & Saturdays.*

Any subjects under the age of 18 will receive a Lake Holiday citation for \$100.00 and may face a State charge and arrest by the LaSalle County Sheriffs Department.
